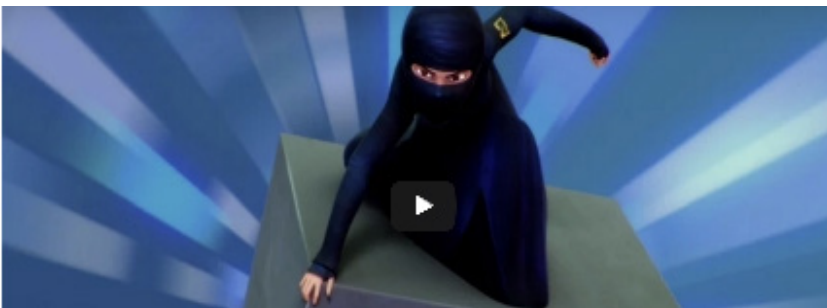

The Library is intended to be a comprehensive tool where governments, practitioners and civil society can access content, toolkits and good practices to counter the narratives of all forms of violent extremism. The password-protected Library includes videos, movies, TV shows, cartoons, books, websites, magazines, blogs, social media campaigns, articles and many others that can be found online or uploaded as files.

LIBRARY ITEMS

Each library item is categorized, tagged and classified by target audience, source, language and related countries. The library items also include a summary of the contents and potential use.

SEARCH FUNCTION AND TAGS

Users can search by keyword and tag from the entire dataset, or browse by the different categories on the home screen.

INTERACTIVE FEATURES: ADD CONTENT, COMMENTS AND RATING SYSTEM

Users also have the ability to share and upload new content to the library, potentially expanding the dataset to include new items and campaigns as they are developed. Users can also comment on existing counter-narratives, and rank the narratives based on their use and applicability.

COLLECTIONS

The Library features two existing collections: one regional collection on South East Asia, and the second on Daesh Defector narratives. Other regional collections include: Middle East and North Africa and East Africa.
